(pause) With longing in our hearts, we pray, All: Come, Lord Jesus

Deacon or Reader:

6. For those who will benefit from our Second Collection in support of *Catholic Community Services*, that the poor and those in crisis may experience God's love through our response, made in Christ's name,

(pause) With longing in our hearts, we pray, All: Come, Lord Jesus

Presider:
