

PASTOR'S NOTE



Even as we move toward July 1st, and the change that soon begins, the bulk of my energies will be spent toward my ministry here at St. Joseph. Having said that, so that I can begin to work with the incoming priests, as well as prepare for my soon forthcoming move, I will

need to ensure that I use my time wisely and efficiently, as best I can.

With this in mind, I anticipate that you will see at last part of the Monday e-newsletter's content duplicated in the Pastor's Note of the Sunday bulletin that follows. More than just reducing my time and energy, part of the reason is also because some of you are more likely to read the Monday enewsletter and others are more likely to read the Pastor's Note, therefore I want to ensure that anything important regarding this pending transition reaches all of you.

One thing I've been asked is, "What is happening to the deacons?" Good question. Thankfully, the deacons will remain in place, so I anticipate that you will still benefit from all the good things that come with Deacon Brian's ministry to the people of St. Joseph, and for those of you who attend the Word & Communion service on Tuesdays, I anticipate that you will still get to see Deacon Pat. Like you, I'm sure, I'm so grateful for our deacons and all they continue to do for us. My guess is that over the three-year exploration of how to integrate as a family, the question will arise of whether a deacon might also be involved in one of the other parishes within the family.

If I'm correct, Our Lady of Sorrows has no deacon at this time. Mary Queen of Peace currently has four deacons. St. Joseph currently has two deacons, although, as you know from his communications to you all, Deacon Pat requested to have Senior Status (which is not exactly retirement, but certainly a reduced role). As for the four deacons at MQP, I'm not exactly aware of the status, whether any have Senior Status or are perhaps part-time.

More to come on how the new arrangement, beginning on July 1st, will affect the Mass schedule—both daily and Sunday Masses. While your preferences for Mass times are absolutely being considered, as we seek to make a workable schedule, it will have to consider that the number of priests for this family (3 parishes, 2 priests), the driving distance between parishes, the seating capacity of parishes, etc. Again, more to come.

In the meantime, let's ensure that we're praying for each other, praying that nurturing trust and openness alleviates angst and any sadness. We're in this together.
